If a player is injured and unable to trial, please notify the Netball SA Office on 8238 0500 during office hours (9am – 5pm Mon-Fri). A doctor's certificate must be presented to the Netball SA Office for noting before 5pm on the Monday after the trial.

Should an injury occur during the weekend, please phone Kate Abraham on 0411 042 282.

Players will be required to provide their own lunch and drinks for the trials.

Ice will be available for any injuries but players will need to provide own strapping.

A squad will be selected for all teams.

Squad players will be required to attend training sessions on Sunday 29th May 2011, Sunday 5th June 2011, Sunday 12th June 2011, Sunday 19th June 2011, Sunday 26th June 2011, Sunday 3rd July 2011 and Sunday 10th July 2011 from 9.30am-12.00noon under the direction of the SASI Coach.

Squad members will be required to carry out a home training programme.

Applicants for the SA 21 & Under Teams must agree to the following conditions:

1. To abide by Constitution and By Laws of the Association.
2. If requested by the Coach Education & Player Development Manager or Umpiring Manager, attend at least one Coaching or Umpiring Clinic conducted by Netball SA within the next 12 months.
3. To be available for all trainings approved by Netball SA Director of Coaching.
4. Note – By Laws 4.3, 4.4 and 4.5 (see below).
5. To assist in public relation activities when requested by Netball SA and as expected by team Sponsor.
6. To conduct myself in a manner befitting an Ambassador for the Association and at all times to act and compete in a sporting manner both on and off the court.
7. To accept that I am to consider myself a promoter of netball and the Association.
8. For any breach of conduct the Manager will arrange for my discipline.
9. I accept that from the time I am named in the team my first sporting obligation is to Netball.
10. I agree to pay a \$50-00 bond within seven (7) days of being named in the team, refunded in full at the completion of my term as a team member provided I have fulfilled my duties to the satisfaction of Netball SA.
11. I accept that any breach of this agreement will be handled by the Netball Development Committee/ Netball SA Board.
12. I agree to comply with the uniform requirements as directed by Netball Development Committee.
13. I agree to pay the expenses as determined by Netball SA Board.
(Note: For 2009 the 21 & Under, 19 & Under and 17 & Under players will be required to pay \$300-00 towards the cost of attending the National Championships, plus uniform expenses.

By Laws – SA 21 & Under teams

4.3 Age and Representative Teams

4.3.1 Age and Representative Teams may consist of up to twelve (12) players.

4.3.2 To be eligible players must:

- (a) be of South Australian birth or residence for not less than three (3) months prior to the All Australia Netball Association entry closing date and continuing up to the Championships or Carnival, or State of Origin.
- (b) be registered with the Association through one of its Divisions or Member Associations.
- (c) participate in an appropriate rules of netball discussion approved by the Netball Development Committee.

4.3.3 A list of players to be considered shall be approved by the Coaching Development Team.

4.4 Selection of Players

4.4.1 Trials shall be held to assist in the selection of players.

4.4.2 Application forms for trials shall be available from the Office Staff. It is the responsibility of players to obtain and complete the necessary application forms.

4.4.3 The completed application forms for trialing must be returned to the Office Staff by the closing date as set by the Coaching Development Team.

- (a) Trials will commence on a date set by the Coaching Development Team and will be no fewer than two (2) weeks and no longer than four (4) weeks.

4.4.4 Players nominating for the 21 & Under Team may be considered for selection in the State Team at the discretion of the State Team Selection Committee.

4.4.5 Selected players shall sign an agreement.

4.4.6 The team shall be released by the Convener of Selectors to the President and Chief Executive Officer for release to the media.

4.5 Selected Players

4.5.1 Players selected in the State, Age and Representative Teams shall:

- (a) carry out all the training set by the Coach.
- (b) attend all training sessions arranged by the Coach: however in the event of illness or injury exceeding fourteen (14) days, a player may be allowed exemption at the discretion of the Board after consultation with the Netball Development Committee.
- (c) recognise that in extenuating circumstances the coach and manager may allow a player to miss a training session and the reasons for non attendance will be included in the manager's report. Should a player be absent from more than one (1) training session, the manager shall advise the Director of Coaching.
- (d) pay by a date stipulated any portion of expenses as may be decided by the Board.
- (e) lodge a set deposit on issue of the Association's playing uniform.

- (f) return in good order and condition and within the time allowed, the playing uniform and any property of the Association on return of which the deposit shall be refunded.
 - (g) recognise the authority of the Manager in all matters not specifically allocated to the Coach.
 - (h) be invited to undertake promotional work for the Association.
- 4.5.2 A selected player may be subject to replacement should she;
- (a) fail to fulfill her obligations, or
 - (b) become unfit for the contest.
- The Coach shall report such player to the Selection Committee who shall meet to receive the report and to interview the Coach and player concerned. Should a replacement be deemed necessary, the selectors shall name the replacement from the next in line of players who attended selection trials.
- 4.5.3 All players in the State, Age and Representative Teams shall be under the sole jurisdiction of their Manager.
- 4.5.4 All members of the State parties shall travel together to and from the All Australia Netball National Championships. (Note: also applies to 21&U, 19&U and 17&U parties where practicable.)
- 4.5.5 Any member of the State, Age and Representative Team Parties may apply to the Convener of the Netball Development Committee to continue her stay at the conclusion of the All Australia Netball National Championships or respective Carnival provided that:
- (a) she has advised the Convener of the Netball Development Committee in writing at least six (6) weeks before the date of departure to the All Australia Netball National Championships or respective Carnival;
 - (b) if the player is under 18 years of age, parental consent shall also be required.
 - (c) she accepts the financial assistance being offered by the Association to her may be withdrawn and that all additional expenses incurred shall be borne by her.
