Winter Season Trials 2012

155 Railway Terrace, Mile End

Registrations are now open for the 2012 winter season. Follow the online registration link on the playing page under external links.

Please take the time to read **ALL** the information provided, before deciding to trial for the Garville Netball Club.

Online registration must be completed by Sunday 29 January 2012

No Player nominations will be accepted after the closing date, payment for trials must be paid when registration is completed online. Please do not leave it until the last minute to complete online registration and payment.

A Trial Fee of **\$100** must be paid upon registration.

Upon selection in a team the \$100 trial fee will be deducted off the season fee for your age group, any player selected and then declining their place will not have their trial fee refunded. If you are not placed in a team, \$75 of the trial fee will be refunded (\$25 being an administration fee).

Please assist the selectors by **NOT** wearing any Garville attire to the trials, and by wearing the same clothes to each trial.

Following Trials

Players will be placed into teams where possible, but we can only enter as many teams as we have accredited coaches and umpires for. Please note that trialling does not guarantee selection, selection for the Garville Netball Club will be at the discretion of the selectors. Grading will take into considerations skill development, team balance and development potential.

If you are not placed in a team, you can be placed on a waiting list, should any vacancies occur.

Garville Policy

Garville Netball Club has a policy to review all performances in the first few weeks of the season to ensure grading is reflective of members playing capabilities. There will be movements between teams where we believe players have been incorrectly placed.
